Exclamation marks (!!) are placed above notes in measures 10, 11, 15, and 16.

Piano: Enters in measure 1 with a mezzo-piano/mezzo-forte (mp/mf) dynamic and a con discrezione (con discrezione) marking. It plays a rhythmic accompaniment in the bass clef.
